  - Asynchronous is difficult, but teachers are preparing classrooms
  - Still planning f2f: Monday-Thursday 9-4; Friday 9-3
  - Slow release to getting kids back in buildings
    - Monday: Kindergarten A-L AM/M-Z PM and 1st-5th asynchronous
    - Tuesday: K-5 A-L in person/M-Z asynchronous
    - Wednesday: K-5 M-Z in person/A-L asynchronous
    - Thursday/Friday: all students
    - My/Our Path: Monday new teachers
    - Most teachers are coming back to in person; some are staying Our Path
    - Gone over new practices with staff-nervous about unknown
    - Safety of staff/students as well as health is priority
    - Mr. Drewno is retiring January 8, hopes to work with new person to make the transition
